Circa 1963, newly-weds Des and Carley Short were set to complete their studies at the Elim Bible Institute in New York, when on their last night, a visiting missionary from the Philippines prayed for Des and Carley, prophesising their return to New Zealand where God will raise up an end time training centre from which He would internationally send out many people to preach and demonstrate the Kingdom of God. Henceforth, the vision for Faith Bible College was planted, and the seed, bearing todays fruit, was to sprout.


Promptly returning to New Zealand via ship, Des and Carley obediently waited on the Lord to direct

their paths. Come 1968, pray-fully believing it was the right time, Des and Carley purchased a beautiful 20 acre green-scape property in the heart of a (then undeveloped) suburb in Tauranga called Welcome Bay. One year later, in 1969, Faiths first cohort of students graduated, and now, more than 50 years later, Faith Bible College has mentored, ministered, and equipped over 4,000 (and counting) graduates serving God in many spheres of influence.

Carley passed away in 2021, and Des, now in his late 90s, has gracefully stepped back from the day-to-day operations of the college. Towards the end of 2023, Des moved into a local retirement village, where he enjoys sharing his profound biblical insights and passion for the truth.

Faith is now under the caring stewardship of Des's family, who, along with a close-knit board and a team of dedicated individuals, carry on the college's legacy with warmth and determination.





Duration: Six Weeks (Monday 17th June - Friday 26th July 2024)

Location: On-Campus (749 Welcome Bay Road, Tauranga, New Zealand)

Curated for those searching for a deeper understanding of the doctrines of Christian faith, Accelerate by Faith Bible College is a systematic course designed to stimulate hunger for God's Word; equipping Christians with the practical and spiritual tools required to encourage a lifetimes discipline of study beyond the surface. Building on weekly topics of study, Accelerate will progress through these topics under the guidance of our excellent teaching staff. Classes will run on-campus Monday through Friday from 8:40am to 1:00pm NZT with afternoons free for focused personal study, course prep-work, Q&A sessions with lecturers, and more.

Whatsmore, Accelerate will host 12 evening sessions on-campus on End-Times, running every Tuesday & Thursday evening from 7pm-8:30pm for the duration of the course. These sessions are open to the wider public, free of charge, and will strengthen believers' understanding of their faith to stand without compromise in a world that continually turns from God and His values.

Week 1: Who is God/Who Am I?

Delving deep into age-old questions, explore the profound implications of the fall of man and unravel the mysteries of the kingdom and government of God.

Week 2: Hearing God

Through His Word, prayer, and prophecy, unlock the course of divine communication and experience a deeper connection with the Almighty. Discover powerful study methods to discern and interpret God's voice within His Word, and cultivate a heart that eagerly seeks His guidance.

Week 3: Equipped to Serve

From grace to sanctification, redemption to reconciliation, gain a deep understanding of these concepts and their significance in your spiritual journey; equipping yourself with wisdom and compassion to serve with love and purpose.

Week 4: Covenant-Keeping God

Explore the intricate aspects of covenant relationships, tracing their origins from the Covenant God made with man in the garden of Eden to the covenant with Noah and the promises to Abraham, and the lesser-known yet profound Salt Covenant, understanding its significance in ancient and contemporary contexts.

Week 5: Under Construction - The Church

Uncover the dynamic construction of the Church, rooted in the rich tapestry of biblical history and prophecy. Explore the profound meaning of 'church,' derived from the Greek 'ekklesia,' and its evolution from the Old Testament Temple to the New Testament Church. Examine Jesus' promise to build His Church and the perpetual appointed times of God, spanning both Old and New Testaments, and gain insight into the tradesmen given to build the Church, the indispensable five-fold gifts bestowed upon the body: apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors, and teachers.

Week 6: Kaleidoscope

Journey into the enigmatic events of Jesus' three days in the heart of the earth, unlocking the depths of His redemptive work between death and resurrection. Explore the reality of the good fight of faith, equipping yourself with a deeper understanding of your spiritual adversary and the weapons at your disposal. Gain insight into the broadness and beauty of the God of Creation, whose majesty and splendour transcend human comprehension.

Accelerate Evening Sessions:

Embark on an extraordinary journey through the Book of Revelation in our captivating evening sessions, open to all. Delve into its enigmatic passages, exploring untraditional perspectives and unravelling the profound messages to the seven churches in Asia Minor. We'll decode the significance of signs and symbols, relating them to the complexities of our modern world, and more. Join us as we journey through Revelation, unlocking its timeless truths and discovering its relevance for today's age.


